Full Time Apprentice

- a) Advertise and find your own

Sign up meeting with your selected Australian Apprenticeship Center

- a) Employer representative
- b) Apprentice
- c) Apprentices guardian if under 18yrs of age
- d) Training plan of selected course AUR31912 Elevating Work Platform Technology (attached)

The employer pays:

- a) Pays apprentice wages while at work and at the tafe (except school base apprentices where you pay for work) www.fairwork.gov.au
- b) Pay apprentice Training Center enrollment fee
- c) Pay Training Center tuition fees (normally \$2 per training hour)
- d) Pay for books and resources required by Training Center
